NOTIFICATION

The 9th January, 2008

No. JDJ(E) 110/80/Pl. 77.-- In exercise of power conferred by the proviso to Article - 309 read with Article - 234 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Assam is pleased to make, in consultation with the Gauhati High Court, the following Rules further to amend the Assam Judicial Service Rules, 2003, hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules, namely :-

1. (1) These rules may be called as the "Assam Judicial Service (Amendment) Rules, 2008."
- (2) They shall come into force at once.

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"In case of recruitment in Grade-III cadre, the selected candidates shall undergo 1 (one) year pre-appointment training as stipulated in Rule – 7 of the Rules, in order of their merit position in the list.";

- (iv) in clause (vi) of the Rule (1) so renumbered, after the words and punctuation **"Clause (iii) above,"** and before the words **"shall be,"** the punctuation mark **","** shall be inserted and thereafter the following shall be inserted, namely :-

" in case of Grade -I cadre," and at the end of the existing clause (vi), the following shall be inserted, namely :-

" In case of Grade-III cadre, the candidates whose names are included in the list prepared under Clause-(iii) above, shall undergo pre-appointment training in reputed Institute/National Law School/State Judicial Academy, as may be decided by the High Court, in the order in which their names appear in the list and on their successful completion of such training for one year, they shall be considered for appointment by the appointing authority in the vacancies notified under Clause (i) above, subject to Rule 9 of the Rules,. The candidates whose names are included in the additional list may similarly be directed to undergo one year's pre-appointment training as specified above and they shall be considered for appointment on successful completion of such training, after the candidates, whose names are included in the list published under Clause- (iii) and who have successfully completed such training ." ;

- (v) for the existing clause – (vii) of the sub-rule (1) so renumbered, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

"(vii) The inclusion of the name of a candidate in any list prepared under clause – (iii) or clause (iv) or on their successful completion of the training as aforesaid, shall not confer any right of appointment to such candidate.";

- (vi) after sub-rule (1) so renumbered, the following new sub-rule (2) shall be inserted, namely :-

"(2) All vacancies in all grades of service either by promotion or direct recruitment, as maybe, shall be filled up in accordance with the time schedule mentioned in Schedule – F. "

4. In the principal Rules, in rule 14, in sub-rule (1), the words **"the officers appointed in Grade-III of the Service and"** shall be omitted.

5. In the principal Rules, in rule 17, --
(i) the existing sub-rule (2) shall be re-numbered as sub-rule (2) (a) and in sub-rule (2)(a) so re-numbered, in the first line, in between the words **"Service"** and the punctuation mark **","** the words **" in Grade -I "** shall be inserted,

(b) twenty five percent by promotion through limited competitive examination of Civil Judge (Senior Division) not having less than five years of qualifying service.
