Sub: **Nomination for Training Courses on Forensic Examination in Sexual Assault Cases- reg.**

Sir,

Government of India, have undertaken a National Mission for the safety of women and a Women Safety Division has been created in Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi. The spirit behind this National Mission and the roles and responsibilities of this Women Safety Division are:

- i) Strengthening investigation and forensic set up in States/UTs
- ii) Training and skill development of investigators
- iii) Creation of Nation Registry of Sexual Offenders
- iv) National Forensic Labs.

Keeping in view the large number of crime being committed against women, especially the increasing number of rape cases and keeping in view the spirit of National Mission of Govt. of India, it has been decided to tackle these offences in an efficient and effective manner so that the accused are appropriately punished and appropriate justice is delivered to the victim. The police personnel, especially the lady officers who are involved in handling of sexual assault cases, accompany survivors are supposed to appropriately handle the exhibits before submission to Forensic Science Laboratory. Medical Officers are supposed to examine survivors and accused and collect various physical evidence. The Forensic Scientists examine these exhibits, prepare their report and submit to the Hon'ble Courts. Prosecutors & Judges are involved in trial of these cases. Each of these functionaries, thus, forms critical link in achieving the goal of the National Mission for Safety of women and children.

It has been decided to enhance the capacity building of Police, prosecution, judiciary, Forensic Scientists as well as of concerned Government Medical Officers by organizing training Courses on "**Forensic Examination in Sexual Assault Cases**".

The LNJJN National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Science will be organizing training Courses on **Forensic Examination of Sexual Assault Cases** for various criminal justice functionaries including government medical officers (who are involved in medico-legal examination in Sexual Offence Cases), Police Officers (Dy.SP/ACP and Above), Prosecution Officers, Judges/Magistrate and Forensic Scientists of the ranks of SSO and above working in various Central/State Forensic Science Laboratories of the Country.

You are requested to nominate officers for these Courses. Medical Doctors and Police Officers may be nominated from **different districts**. The schedule of courses to be conducted from 27 September 2019 to 29th February 2020 are as under. The numbers of Officers from each category to be nominated by the States/UTs for each course are indicated in the table given below:
