No.eCF. 57226/2018/19: As per provision of Rule-11(5) of the Notaries Rule, 1956, the Governor of Assam is pleased to appoint the District & Sessions Judge of every district and the Presiding Officers of the Sub-divisional Judicial Magistrate Court in each Sub-division, for undertaking inspection of the register maintained by the Notaries within their jurisdiction at such times, not often than twice a year, as the District & Sessions Judge / Presiding Officer may fix. District & Sessions Judge / Presiding Officers of Sub-divisional Judicial Magistrate are empowered to lodge report to the govt. for taking action against a Notary in terms of the provision of Rule-11(5) in appropriate cases.
